

On 10/23/20 at 4:00pm D/Tpr's Kevin Pirvu and Stephanie Chang went to Rd. They indicated that the Tel Nine Office Plaza was located at the venue. Upon entering the public area Detectives found that had a placard affixed for Pirvu and Chang stated they saw an unknown male and female working inside. I found a non-profit business named that was created by former State of Michigan Senator Mike Nofs. Nofs last served in the Michigan Senate in 2018. The non-profits stated purpose is community enhancement and charitable activities. Looking through the annual statements I found no connection between Mike Nofs, COLLABORATION WITH MICHIGAN SECRETARY OF STATE: Investigators had several online meetings with AG Investigators, Muskegon PD, MSP and representatives from the Michigan Secretary of State. Michigan SOS Analyst Corey Ames prepared a spreadsheet with information supplied by the Muskegon City Clerk's Office and Muskegon Police Department. Each suspicious voter registration form and other samples were sent to Ames for analysis and comparison to the MDOS Qualified Voter File and Driver Information Database. On 10/26/20 the spreadsheet highlighting irregularities was then sent to Muskegon PD for follow up investigation and comparison. FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION MUSKEGON PD: On 10/27/20 Detective Luker conducted follow up investigation based on the analysis done by MDOS Analyst Ames. Detective Luker contacted me and reported the below findings based on his follow up work: A. Detective Luker contacted stated she was approached by an acquaintance and badgered to fill out a voter registration was shown a completed voter registration application by Detective Luker and she stated she filled out the form but did not sign it. stated the signature at the bottom of the form was not hers and she had no idea who had signed the form. was shown a 2nd completed form with her name and supposed signature on it. stated that was not her handwriting and she had no idea who completed the form or signed it. The form had the following errors: fictitious last four numbers of social security number, fictitious phone number and invalid address (affiant knows McLaughlin and Terrace to be an intersection and not a residence. B. Detective Luker examined (2) voter registration applications to conduct follow up and found the following issues. Detective Luker found the address on both forms does not exist. - D. Detective Luker and your affiant examined a batch of (18) separate voter registration applications. When the applications were printed out and placed side by side the handwriting on the (18) forms appear to be done by the same writer and numerous signatures have similar characteristics. Your affiant noted that multiple forms were missing key information, had duplicate last names at different addresses and had inaccurate information.
- E. After consulting with Muskegon PD Detectives and MDOS Analyst Corey Ames your affiant would describe the results as finding that a quantity of the voter applications forms are clearly fraudulent, a quantity of the voter application forms are highly suspicious having either erroneous or are missing key pieces of information and merit further follow up and a quantity of the voter registration forms appear to be legitimate based on cross checks and database reviews.

SURVEILLANCE 10/28/20 & 10/29/20 GRAND HAVEN/MUSKEGON HEIGHTS:

On 10/28/20 I received a call from Detective Luker. His search warrant for cell phone location information for elapsed but was renewed and activated on 10/28/20. Luker stated that GPS location showed phone was at the Best Western in Grand Haven, MI.

On 10/28/20 at 9:15am I went to the Best Western and located a black Nissan Sentra (MI Reg / EDL6130) in the parking lot. A short time later a gray mini-van arrived and parked next to the Nissan. An unidentified black male went into the hotel and left a short time later. Believing the mini-van may be a rental and related to the investigation I followed the van from Grand Haven to Muskegon Heights. The van entered the parking lot at the northwest corner of Hoyt and Broadway. An awning on the business stated it was the "California Eyewear". I did a search on the business and found California Eyewear was no longer in business. The Dodge Caravan was observed to have North Carolina Registration HCA3208. Your affiant ran a LEIN check and left eastbound on Broadway in the van. I lost visual contact with the van shortly after.

Nissan Sentra and went to a laundry-mat in Grand Haven. Detective Kyle Hall contacted the Best Western
hotel staff and was able to confirm that had a room rented at the hotel and was due to check
out at 10/29/20. Detective Eric Rasch from Grand Haven DPS contacted management and confirmed that
was in room and is due to check out by 11am on 10/29/20.
I returned to the California Eyewear storefront located at 160 E. Broadway at approximately 5pm. Three
different Dodge Rental mini-vans including the one that was followed from hotel in Grand Haven were
observed at the business front. Numerous
unknown persons were witnessed getting out of the mini-van vans and both coming in and going out of the
front door of the business.

On 10/29/20 at approximately 10:30am I spoke with Detective Luker. Detective Luker stated he went to 160 E. Broadway at approximately 10:00am and observed two parked mini-vans at the business but no persons inside the business or the vans. Detective Luker was able to retrieve a bag of trash from the rear of the business. Detective Luker found paper in the bag with information about employee agreements, potential lists of canvassers and COVID policies.


On Wednesday (10-28-20) I received a call from D/F/Lt. Anderson regarding this investigation. He asked if I would execute a search warrant on Thursday (10-29-20) at the 'Best Western' in the City of Grand Haven. D/F/Lt. Anderson said that he would be executing a search warrant at the same time, at a field office in Southfield. D/F/Lt. Anderson stated that Muskegon Police Department (MPD) Detective Kory Luker was the MPD contact regarding this case and that he would be assisting at the Grand Haven location.

At approximately 8:00am on Wednesday (10-29-20), I received a call from MPD Det. Kory Luker. Det. Luker said that he had been monitoring the phone pings of the suspect the City of Grand Haven at approximately 5:30am. After receiving this information, I drove through the parking lot of the 'Best Western' and noted that we would wait until 10:00am, the time of the search warrant in Southfield, and then execute the search warrant at the 'Best Western.'
